“Hikikomori” high schooler Rintaro Natsuki suddenly finds himself the owner of the family bookstore following his grandfather's passing. Soon after, Rintaro is confronted by a magical cat with a big request - to help him save the books of the world from those who mistreat them. What follows is a series of adventures that will charm readers of all ages, capturing both the fantasy of a Studio Ghibli movie and the earnest whimsy of *The Little Prince*. Where this story really shines is in its philosophical analysis of what reading has come to represent in modern society - and how one can begin to cultivate a more joyful relationship to books.
